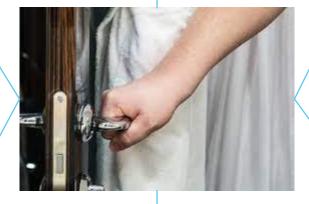

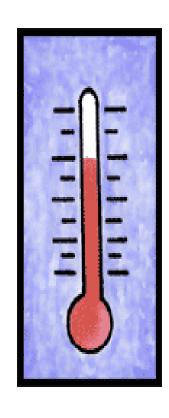


Health Effects of Cold Homes

Ideal room temperatures:

Living room	21°C
Kitchen	18°C
Bathroom	22°C
Bedrooms	18°C
Hall / Stairs	16°C

(World Health Organisation statistics)



Above 18°C (64oF):

No adverse health effects

Below 16°C (61oF):

Risk of respiratory infections

Below 12°C (54oF):

Increased blood pressure

Below 9°C (48oF):

Deep body temperature falls

At Risk of Fuel Poverty

Respiratory: chronic Cardiovascular: ischaemic Younger: Under 5 Older: Over 65 obstructive pulmonary heart disease; cerebrovascular disease disease; asthma Alzheimer's disease: Neurobiological and Substance abuse vascular dementia; other related diseases (e.g. Cancer forms of dementia; fibromyalgia, ME)

Limited mobility; osteoarthritis; other musculoskeletal conditions

Moderate to severe mental illness:

severe depression or anxiety disorder

Haemoglobinopathies: sickle cell disease; thalassaemia

Severe learning disabilities

Autoimmune disease: lupus; multiple sclerosis; diabetes; rheumatoid arthritis; cancer; fibromyalgia; ME

Recent hospital admission resulting from a fall at home

How we Help: Get Home Energy Grants

Greater London Authority's Warmer Homes Grant for £5,000-25,000 of retrofit work to your home to increase its energy efficiency.

- To apply you need to:
- live in Greater London
- own or rent your own home, landlords can apply as long as the tenant is eligible
- Are in receipt of a means-tested benefit OR have a low household income (less than £20,000 a year after rent/mortgage and council tax deductions)
- Have a property EPC rating of D, E, F and G

- Reduce energy and water bills

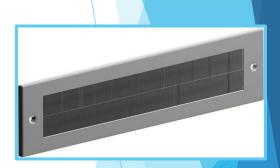
Measures Include:

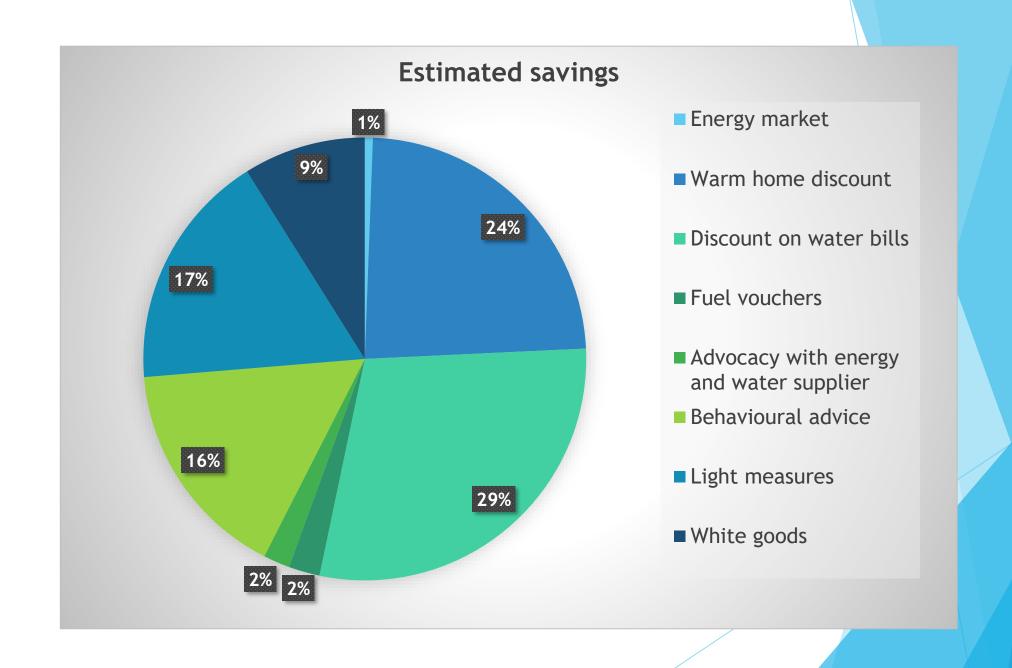
