To date, over 200,000 Achievement Awards have been presented!





Examples of Grant Spends





Equipment

(e.g. sports, camping, arts, outside space, furniture, specialist training kit, training kit)



Trips

(e.g. camping, residentials, theatre trips, restaurant visit, bowling, cinema, Theme Park)



Opportunities

(e.g. training, learning a new skill, young person taking coaching qualifications, bringing in a specialist coach, after school clubs)



Projects

(e.g. creating a video, end of season disco, fundraising event, tournament with other clubs, environmental project)

Grant Period

- Either Jan-Jun or Sep-Nov
- We send materials and grants at start of each period
- You then nominate, select and present award winners
- Speak to award winner and decide how to use £300 grant
- Report back to us by Jun 30th and Nov 30th
- Want to know Who, Why and how grant has been used

Other Jack Petchey





Reader Award – recognise staff, volunteer, parent, manager or other significant adult aged 21+ in your organisation. They can then apply for a grant of up to £1000 for a project that benefits young people.



Educational Visit – funding for two educational trips e.g. The Football Museum, tour of Lord's Cricket Ground. Up to £1,200 available for each trip.

Individual Grant For Volunteering – up to £400 available for a young person to take part in a volunteering project.

Eligibility Criteria



- Registered Charity/ state secondary school/ 'not for profit' organisation
- Be based in London or Essex
- Have been operating for at least one year
- Regularly work with young people aged 11 25
- Active attendance of more than 12 young people.
- Cannot be a profit-making company, private school or group established to promote a specific political/religious belief



Application Process

- 1. Application
- 2. Documentation/Reference check
- 3. Coordinator Training
- 4. Observation and Assessment
- 5. Decision
- 6. Set up!



Documentation



You will need to upload the following documents:

- Latest signed, approved accounts
- A bank statement dated within the last three months
- Constitution or Memorandum & Articles of Association (signed and dated)
- Up to date safeguarding policy
- Public liability insurance certificate

You will also need to provide the details of:

• Two referees; one with professional experience of your organisation and the other a parent or service user
