You may apply for a grant of up to £5,000. There are three simple parts to the application process.

Part 1 - Please complete a London Youth due diligence form and submit the four documents outlined on the form via the portal.

Part 2 - Submit a detailed budget outlining how money will be spent via the portal. (please ensure this aligns with what you submit in your application form).

Part 3 - You will need to fill in this application form in full via the portal here.

Grants will need to be spent by 31st October 2024

- Community Links Bromley
- Bromley Children & Families Voluntary Sector Community Forum
- Young people from the borough

Eligibility

As stated in the supporting guidance document, there are five eligibility criteria you must meet to apply for this grant.

Please answer Yes/No to the following five questions to establish if you are eligible for this grants scheme.

- 1. Does your organisation work with young people?
- 2. Is your organisation a registered e.g. charity, not for profit company or CIC?
- 3. Does your organisation have an annual turnover of less than £1 million?
- 4. Is your organisation based in Bromley or does it currently deliver youth work in Bromley?
- 5. **Is your organisation willing and able to provide basic information for due diligence?** (see application guidance document for information on what is required).

If you answered no to any of the questions above, please do not continue with your application as you are not eligible for this grant scheme. If you answered no to any of the questions above, do not continue with your application as you are not eligible for this grant scheme.
