Voice & Partnership

Borough Community Resilience Plan

Community Links Bromley, in partnership with the Borough Emergency Planning and Corporate Resilience Lead, are currently undertaking work to



engage, test and learn, and co-produce

new approaches to local community resilience in Bromley.

- A short survey seeking individuals and organisations views on community resilience was published on 19 June. We will use this feedback to help co-produce a community emergency plan for Borough.
- Hold face-to-face workshops around the emerging findings.
- Engage with a minimum of six local organisations in Penge/Anerley to assess community preparedness for emergencies.
- Share findings with community organisations at a minimum of three local events.



Funding & investment

KTR Fund

- 5 April - 13 May
- 31 applications received, totalling **£124,000** worth of bids

- KAB awarded **£4,716** Digital Grant from Clarion Futures
